The argument *connects* the abstract/general/theoretical to the concrete/specific/ particular (e.g., applies theory to a case study or artistic/creative work).

The project reaches an identifiable and defensible *conclusion*.

Excellent Good Fair Poor Unacceptable. Opt. Comments:

The project is effectively organized, *well-written* (grammatically correct, with technical terms defined), and free of spelling and punctuation errors. [Computer spell-checked]

The project is of appropriate length. (80 pages text for a typical project combining library research with a case study; 40 pages for written component of performance based project
