Septic Maize

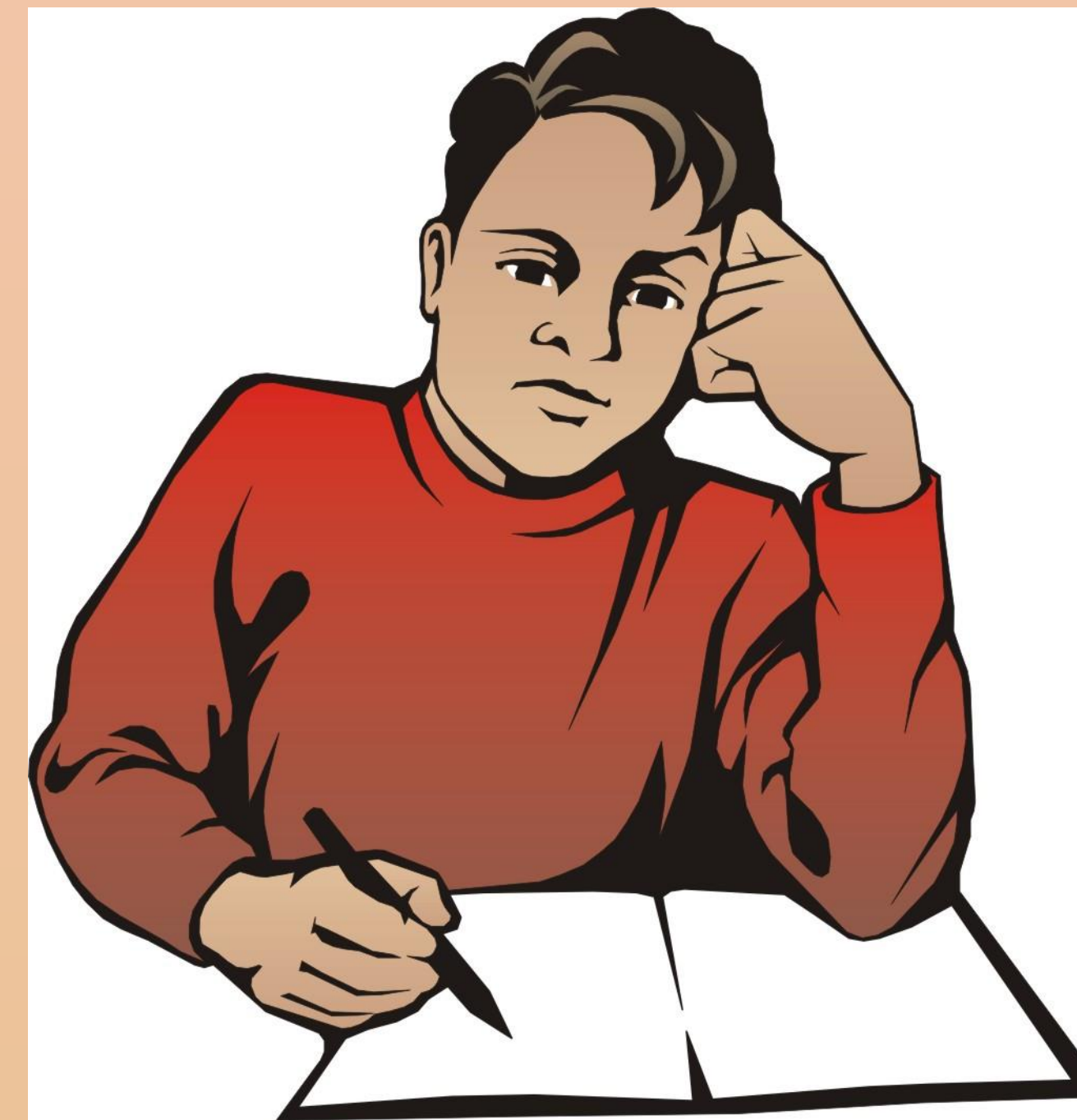
